Dear Mr. Secretary,

I am hereby filing, in accordance with Article II, Section 17 of the Pennsylvania Constitution, a preliminary reapportionment plan for the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania, which was approved by the Legislative Reapportionment Commission on this date by a vote of 4-1. Such plan consists of a composite listing of the Senate and House of Representatives Districts, denominated Senate #1 and House #1-A, as prepared by the Legislative Data Processing Center. I am also providing data regarding the population of the senatorial and representative districts having the smallest and largest population, and the percentage variation of such districts from the average populations for senatorial and representative districts. Finally, I am providing hand-drawn maps of the House and Senate districts, as well as authorizing the Legislative Data Processing Center to release computer discs containing the data described above. I hereby direct that the Secretary of the Commonwealth publish the preliminary reapportionment plan, as set forth in Article II, Section 17 of the Pennsylvania Constitution. Kindly note that the 30-day comment period in which citizens may file exceptions to the preliminary reapportionment plan shall expire on October 25, 1991 at midnight.
